## 10 Cafés and Pubs

### Bohemia Bagel

It's hard to believe now, but Prague had no bagels until American entrepreneurs opened this shop here in 1997, serving fresh-baked bagels, sandwiches and endless cups of coffee. Open late. **☎ Lázeňská 19 • Map C3**

### Hospůdka Na Čertovce

This Kampa Island pub serves good beer and coffee at a fraction of the price found on the other side of the block. **☎ Hrozená 6 • Map D3**

### U zeleného čaje

Serving imported teas, sandwiches and salads, "At the Green Tea" offers a welcome change from the ubiquitous beer and fried food. **☎ Nerudova 19 • Map C2**

### Cafe Čertovka

The stairway leading to this café's riverside patio is so narrow it needs its own traffic lights. They say President Václav Havel took Pink Floyd here for beer. **☎ U lužického semináře • Map D2**

### Bar Bar

The salads, waffles and crêpes served here make an excellent light lunch, but you'll have trouble finding a seat in the evening. **☎ Všeňdova 17 • Map C4**

### U Kocoura

You might think the regulars at this pub on Malá Strana's main drag would be used to tourists by now, but don't be

### Chiméra

### U Maltéze

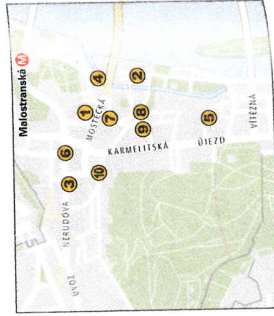
The cold Budvar served here is the best. If they're serving homemade sausage, don't miss it. **☎ Maltézské náměstí 3 • Map C3**
